



Scholarship Program

Eligibility Criteria & Application Requirements

The Iowa Restaurant Association Education Foundation (IRAEF) Scholarship Program is available for students enrolled in or accepted to a culinary arts, hospitality management or other foodservice-related post-secondary program. Preference is given to Iowa residents who are current graduating ProStart students and ProStart alumni.

Eligibility Criteria

- United States Citizen or Permanent Resident in the United States.
- Preference is given to Iowa residents who are current graduating ProStart students and ProStart alumni.
- Applicant must be enrolled or accepted as a full-time or substantial part-time student at an accredited post-secondary institution, college or university for the 2023-2024 school year. A substantial part-time student is enrolled for more than 6 credit hours per semester.
- Applicant's major must be in a culinary arts, hospitality management or other restaurant/hospitality management/foodservice-related post-secondary program.
- Applicant must plan to be enrolled for at least two consecutive terms.

Application Requirements

Note: The submission of any materials with an application other than those requested will be disregarded. Example: newspaper articles, resume, reports, etc.

- Complete and submit application form, duly signed and certified. By completing one application, you will be considered for the Iowa Restaurant Association Education Foundation's Scholarships being offered for the 2023-2024 school year.
- Submit transcript from each high school attended (copies of your transcript will be accepted). Only one transcript required.
- Submit proof of enrollment in or acceptance to an accredited post-secondary culinary arts, hospitality management or other restaurant/hospitality management/foodservice-related post-secondary program. **Note: If application for admission has been filed, but is pending when this scholarship application is submitted, scholarship will be awarded contingent upon acceptance to a qualified culinary arts, hospitality management or other restaurant-foodservice-related post-secondary program.**
- Submit one or more letters of recommendation on letterhead from current or previous teachers or employers. (Recommended: 1 Professional & 1 Personal OR 2 Professional.)
- Submit **TYPED** completed essays. **If you do not answer the essay questions with your submission, your application will be rejected. Be sure to check for proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation. It is acceptable to have a teacher, counselor or parent review your responses to the essay questions for any possible errors.**

***Take Note...**These are the same essay questions asked on the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation Scholarship Application. Therefore, save your answers!

Scholarship Committee will score the following:

- Presentation of application and essays (spelling, punctuation, neatness, etc.). **(30%)**
- Restaurant-related work experience. **(20%)**
- Transcript included. **(5%)**
- Contents of letter or letters of recommendation. **(20%)**
- Response to essay questions. **(20%)**
- Level of ProStart participation (*check one below*). **(5%)**

- Applying for National ProStart Certificate
- Received National ProStart Certificate
- Not offered in my school

Important Deadlines

- April 28: Scholarship Application closes
- June: Scholarship Application Review & Judging
- July: Scholarship award notifications
- Early August: Scholarship payments mailed to post-secondary institutions
- November: Scholarship recipients recognized at Iowa Restaurant Association Awards Ceremony (*more details will be sent to all scholarship recipients*)

All applicants will be notified of their status via U.S. Mail and/or Email and/or Phone.
