Essay 3. Describe a great challenge that you have had to face. How did you overcome it and what personal characteristics do you believe helped you? (Min. word count: 100, Max. word count: 500)

(Questions to consider: What was the challenge? How did this challenge affect you? How did you overcome it? What did you learn from it?)

Essay 4. Describe what positive impact you would like to make in the restaurant/foodservice/hospitality industry through your education. (Min. word count: 50, Max. word count: 100)

(Questions to consider: What do you hope to contribute to the restaurant/foodservice/hospitality industry? What issues do you hope to solve? How will you make the industry better?)
